Parents in Douglas County are inviting area teachers and education support professionals from across Colorado to stand beside them at the **Rally 4 Teachers and Kids** to support public education and teachers. The event is this Friday, Sep. 27, at 4:30 p.m. in front of the school administration building (Wilcox Building, 620 Wilcox St., Castle Rock).

The teachers in Douglas County have been dismissed and treated poorly by the School Board for a long time, so Douglas County parents are staging this rally to let teachers know they have support. The parent group states, "We need this rally to draw community awareness to the horrible conditions our amazing teachers are subjected by this oppressive Board." The parents are hoping to gather hundreds of community members, parents, students, and teachers to attract a big media presence and draw attention to four School Board seats that are up in the November election.

Supporters are encouraged to bring homemade signs that say "My teacher, My hero", "No Bullies at School, No Bullies on the Board", "Teachers Deserve a Voice" or similar message. However, the group requests no pro-union signs or clothing as the Board will use anti-union rhetoric to discredit the rally in the conservative county.

Come out for the **Rally 4 Teachers and Kids** and show the DougCo School Board that WE ALL STAND UNITED WITH OUR TEACHERS! – Friday, Sep. 27, 4:30, at the Wilcox Building in Castle Rock.
